

Information under Article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 (“personal data protection code”)

The European Federation for Animal Science, an international non-governmental organisation having its headquarters in Rome (Italy), Via G. Tomassetti, 3/A1 (hereinafter “EAAP”), in its capacity of data controller, pursuant to Article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 (“personal data protection code”) informs that:

1. Purposes of the processing of personal data

The personal data directly collected within the scope of its activities from the data subject, from third parties, or otherwise acquired will be processed by EAAP for the implementation and management (within the European Union) of a database of European and international researchers in biology applications to farm animals, with the primary, but not exclusive, aim of disseminating animal science and research results, improving professional and scientific relationships among researchers, as well as achieving specific, lawful purposes as set out in the relevant Statute and By-laws of EAAP.

2. Modalities of the processing of personal data

The personal data provided, or otherwise acquired, may be processed with the help of paper, informatics and telematics means, in compliance with the principles of fairness, legality, transparency, protection of confidentiality, for the time necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data are collected.

3. Nature of providing personal data

Providing personal data is optional and voluntary. However, refusing to provide data may entail the impossibility for EAAP to improve professional and scientific relationships between researchers, as well as the impossibility to promote the dissemination and advancement/progress of the research in animal science, as provided for by the Statute of EAAP.

4. Categories of entities which the personal data may be communicated to

The data are not released or communicated to third parties, except in cases expressly provided for by law and, in any case, in the manner permitted by law.

5. Rights of the data subject

The data subject can enforce all the rights under [Article 7](#) of the personal data protection code.

6. Data controller, data processor and person in charge of the processing

The data controller is EAAP, an international non-governmental organisation having its headquarters in Via G. Tomassetti, 3/A1, 00161, Rome (Italy).
