

EAAP YOUNG SCIENTISTS AWARD 2018

1. The EAAP Young Scientists Award 2018 is granted to early career researchers demonstrating outstanding research performance with the European dimension and perspective
2. Individual members born after September 1st 1980 are eligible for this award
3. A candidate can be nominated by himself/herself or by an Individual Member
4. Candidates who already submitted their candidatures the years before are welcome to do it again. Only those who were awarded cannot participate
5. Nomination must be supported by another Individual Member
6. Nominations must be submitted to EAAP office (eleonora@eaap.org) not later than April 7th 2018
7. Nominations must be accompanied by:
 - Curriculum Vitae
 - European experiences (if not in CV) such as participation in EU projects or benefiting EU grants
 - List of scientific publications and of products (e.g. patents)
 - List of eventual presentations at the EAAP Annual Meetings
 - Letter of support by another Individual Member
 - Eventual EAAP related scholarships received
8. The Scientific Committee will review nominations and propose up to three candidates to the Selection Committee composed of the President of EAAP, Vice President Science and the member of the Council in charge of the EAAP Young Club.
9. The Selection Committee will present its recommendations to the Council for endorsement.
10. The winner will be awarded ceremony in Dubrovnik (August 27th, 2018) with a plate and a free registration for the following Annual Meeting (Ghent, 2019)
11. The winner will be invited to present a paper at the following Annual Meeting (Ghent, 2019).
